



James E. West (1876 – 1948) was the first Chief Scout Executive of the Boy Scouts of America. He served in that position for more than three decades.

To honor his legacy and his contributions to the Scouting movement, approximately 90 individuals and/or corporations from the Leatherstocking Council have become James E. West Fellows over the last 107 years, or they have honored a friend or relative by joining this fellowship on behalf of someone else —such as in honor of a new Eagle Scout, Silver Beaver recipient, a retirement, a special accomplishment, or anniversary—or in memory of a special individual.

In addition to receiving a pin and framed certificate, beginning in 2019, the Leatherstocking Council will begin permanently recognizing its James E. West Fellows by affixing name plates to a new donor Wall of Honor for those who make a minimum gift of \$1,000 in cash or marketable securities, over three years, to the Leatherstocking Council's endowment fund.
