



Blizzard Adventure Camp 2021

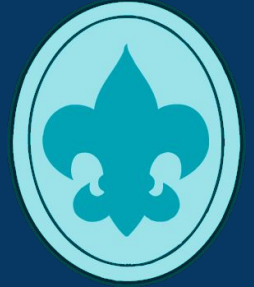
January 16th and 17th, 2021 at Camp Kingsley

Ice Fishing Program



This activity will meet off-site at Delta Lake State Park. Trail lunch will be provided at program site

Activities include:

Getting out on the ice, having fun and learning about the differences for winter fishing. Also, many requirements of Fishing Merit Badge.

Two 1-day sessions offered on 1/16 and 1/17. Limit 12 scouts per session.

Snowmobile Repair Program



Activities include:

Automobile Maintenance Merit Badge through snowmobile repair.

Snow Kayaking, Sledding

1-day session offered on 1/16 only. Limit 8 scouts only.

(Slightly Sub-)Arctic Exploration Expedition



This activity will be on the trail the whole day.

Activities include:

Exploration Merit Badge and some requirements of Geocaching MB. Hiking, Orienteering skills, Lunch on the trail.
